Resolution No. 58 of 2021

**RE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF ROAD SIGNS
ON TOWN ROADS PURSUANT TO DUTCHESS COUNTY LOCAL LAW**

WHEREAS, Dutchess County has recently passed a local law establishing a program to install and utilize cameras to enforce the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law prohibiting the passing of stopped school buses; and

WHEREAS, each school bus will now be equipped with several cameras to enforce said law; and

WHEREAS, the Dutchess County Local Law requires the posting of signs on all roads entering into the County advising travelers that the Vehicle and Traffic Law is now being enforced by cameras; and

WHEREAS, three Amenia Town roads, Knibloe Hill Road, Benton Hill Road, and Clark Hill Road have been identified as border entrance roads into the County; and

WHEREAS, the proposed signs to be installed have been approved and accepted by the New York State Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed signs are exempt from any permitting requirements under the Town of Amenia Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Amenia has determined that the placement of the signs set forth above is in the best interest of the Town and the safety of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. The recitations set forth above are incorporated in this Resolution as if fully set forth and adopted herein.

2. The Town Board of the Town of Amenia hereby acknowledges the Dutchess County Local Law establishing a program utilizing cameras to enforce the New York State Vehicle Traffic Law prohibiting the passing of a stopped school bus.

3. The Town Board of the Town of Amenia hereby authorizes the posting of the New York State Department of Transportation approved signs to be placed on the Town roads set forth above at each border entrance into the County.
