

FEMA Assistance Available 11/29/21 for Hurricane Ida Damage

Dutchess County has received the **Individual Assistance** declaration from FEMA for impacts sustained from the remnants of Hurricane Ida in early September 2021. This declaration allows for residents, property owners, and small businesses to **apply for assistance** from FEMA at

www.disasterassistance.gov.

In an effort to support this process, representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Small Business Administration will be present **at Amenia Town Hall on**

Monday, November 29 from 10am-6pm.

This will allow for residents to apply for assistance in person, if they choose to, and to have questions answered about potential damage and/or claims. The Small Business Administration (SBA) also serves as a resource for residents and businesses impacted by this storm event.
