1. Tomas Espinosa requested sponsorship of basketball clinic at Webutuck School. Program will serve 7th to 12th grade from 2:30-5pm 1 day a week at Webutuck School to allow kids access to the 5pm after school bus home. He is coordinating with Webutuck School on the day. Commission agreed to sponsor
2. Pickle Ball refused to consider a different start time stating that 5:30 was too early to start. Also stated that at times their program runs beyond 8pm as they do not have space to operate 1 game at a time. Webutuck Elementary gym is available to pickleball on Tuesdays from 6-9pm which is also double their current space. They requested an opportunity to visit space
3. Pitching clinic informed us that their program actually runs Nov to March. Mon/We'd/Fri. Previously there appeared to be no issue with moving pitching clinic to Webutuck Schools. Now they have concerns that they will not have space available to them. Once again Webutuck School has confirmed that there will be space for the pitching clinic. Webutuck Elementary gym is available Mon thru Friday 6-9pm
4. Discussed concession stand with WLL. They have a meeting with Dutchess BOH on Feb 16th at 3:30 pm to review any needed upgrades needed to satisfy BOH rules to allow operation of concession stand
5. Presented Didona Architect preliminary analysis of walk thru of Wassaic Park. Need for parking and availability to create parking will drive Master Plan. Concern was

expressed of insurance requirements to have BMX/Skateboard park available to public. Commission needs to get a handle on what those cost would be
