Artists will include David Paton, who carries the folk music tradition of his parents, Folk Legacy Records founders Sandy and Caroline Paton of Sharon CT. Dave is a virtuoso on the hammer dulcimer and English concertina, whose ringing and reedy acoustic tones conjure up 19th century holiday celebrations. Joseph Sobol, a recent arrival in Amenia, is a nationally known exponent of the contemporary cittern, a lush modern variant of an old British Isles ancestor of the guitar. He has released five CDs, both solo and with his group Kiltartan Road. Guests include Isa Simon, a brilliant young fiddler and singer now living in New York City; Ambrose Verdibello, a versatile fiddler and guitarist whose repertoire ranges from Irish to old-time to jazz. They will be joined by Andrew Forbes whose razor-sharp technique delivers traditional, contemporary, and original bagpipe music, definitive in style and unparalleled in sound. There will be singalongs to holiday songs and dance tunes familiar and new, and perhaps even a dance or two!
